# A Deeper Look

## Open Shelter Home

As an NGO, we believe that every child deserves a safe and secure environment in which to grow and thrive. Unfortunately, there are many children in our community who are abandoned, neglected, or living in poverty, and they are at risk of experiencing trauma and hardship that can have lasting effects on their well-being. That's why we have made it our mission to operate a shelter home for abandoned children, and those who are rescued from child labor. Our goal is to provide these children with a loving and supportive environment, and as such we are committed to ensuring that every child in our care feels valued, respected, and empowered to realize their full potential, regardless of their circumstances.





Project Snehachal, initiated by Naya Sawera in Jan 2019, was set up to provide love, shelter, security, nutrition, and medical care to the kids. On Feb 2022, we opened our own shelter home to house more than 25 children with special needs who were abandoned by their families because of being born with abnormalities. We also take care of children rescued from child labor from different states.

At our shelter home, we take a holistic approach to care that addresses the physical, emotional, and psychological needs of each child. Our staff works closely with the child to help them adjust to their new surroundings and feel safe and supported. Our main aim is to ensure social justice, equality and protection of basic human rights of children. We provide motherly care, peaceful environment, and nutritional food to the children.

In the year of 2022-23, we welcomed 182 bright young souls into our care. Among them, 11 precious children from the previous year found the strength to continue their journey with us, a testament to the unyielding bond we share. As we witnessed their growth and transformation, 161 of these extraordinary kids underwent a heartwarming process of rehabilitation, guiding them towards a future filled with hope and promise.



We organize regular outings and field trips for the children in our shelter home. We take them to visit outdoor spaces and on educational trips such as a movie show, restaurants, historical monuments, parks, etc., where they can connect with nature and experience the beauty of the world around them.



At our NGO, we understand that festivals are an important part of the cultural fabric of our society, and we believe that every child deserves to experience the joy and excitement of these celebrations. We celebrate festivals with the children in our shelter home in a variety of ways, depending on the nature of the festival and the preferences of the children.

For example, during Diwali, we decorate the shelter home with colorful lights and rangolis, and we light sparklers and distribute sweets to the children. On Christmas, we decorate a Christmas tree and organize a gift-giving ceremony, with gifts donated by our generous supporters. We also organize cultural events and performances, where the children can showcase their talents and learn about the traditions of different communities. These celebrations provide the children with an opportunity to experience the joy and warmth of a family, something which may have been missing from their lives before they arrived at the shelter home. Our goal is to create a sense of belonging and togetherness, and to create happy memories that will last a lifetime.



## Sarthak

As an NGO, we recognize that the elderly population often faces unique challenges and vulnerabilities in our society. Many elderly people are at risk of social isolation, neglect, and abuse, and they may struggle to access the care and support they need to maintain their well-being.

That's why we decided to start our old age home under the project Sarthak. Here we provide a safe and supportive environment for elderly people who may be facing difficult circumstances.

We provide short-term stay, long-term stay, adult daycare and various other facilities with utmost Love & Care.

More than 130 older people found comfort and help at Sarthak Old Age Home, which made a big difference in their lives. They came from different families, some were very poor, others were mistreated by their own family, and some felt really sad and lonely. While 20 stayed for a short time, it was the 50 elderly people who benefited the most from the project. Sarthak became a safe place for them, where they felt like they belonged and found a new sense of purpose. It shows us how powerful kindness and caring can be, and how it can truly change the lives of older people.

We also provide a sense of community and belonging, with opportunities for socialization and engagement with peers. Our goal is to help the elderly in our care live with dignity, respect, and independence, and to ensure that they can enjoy their golden years to the fullest.

By providing a safe and supportive environment, we hope to make a positive difference in the lives of the elderly in our community.

## Saksham

As an NGO, we understand that people living in slums face many difficulties in accessing education, healthcare, and job opportunities.

That's why we have started a project to raise awareness and teach important skills to help children and women from poor backgrounds. Our goal is to empower them to become more independent and self-sufficient.

We focus on providing education and training in various fields to help them gain the skills they need for a better future. Through our program called Naya Sawera Sanstha Saksham Kendra, we offer computer training, tailoring and embroidery training, and beautician training to girls and women in different areas of the city.

We also work to promote awareness about health and hygiene, and provide nutritious food and clothing through donations. By helping slum dwellers gain access to education and training, we aim to break the cycle of poverty and create a brighter future for the entire community. Every week we provide to the children cooked nutritious food, fruits, clothes, sweaters, woolen clothes, etc. Naya Sawera is running 3 centers where more than 200 children are benefited every year.

We believe that everyone has the right to a better life, and we are committed to making a positive difference in the lives of slum dwellers in our community.

## Days of Pride

We understand that access to sanitary pads is a basic necessity that many women and girls cannot afford. This can have serious health implications, and can also impact girls' education and their ability to participate fully in society.



For countless girls and women, sanitary pads are an unaffordable luxury. Thousands of girls explained that they were forced to resort to unsanitary and sometimes unsafe measures to meet their needs.



To address this issue, we launched this initiative to ensure sanitary pad access to the needy. We work with local communities and volunteers to distribute free sanitary pads to girls and women.

Our goal is to ensure that all women and girls have access to safe and effective menstrual products, regardless of their economic situation. We successfully distributed free sanitary pads to women and girls across ten settlements. In the year of 2022 we distributed 2,70,000 sanitary pads to fulfill needs of women and girls who lacked resources.

Around 780 babies have been successfully delivered under this campaign. 80 new lives were brought into this world in this year under the KOKH campaign



We understand that pregnant women from financially poor background may struggle to access the care and support they need to ensure a healthy pregnancy and a safe delivery. To address this issue, we have launched an initiative to help them by providing them with nutritious food, prenatal vitamins, and regular checkups to monitor their health, for the first 9 months.

Awareness again is an important part of this campaign. We try to make the women and their families aware of good practices while the lady is expecting a baby. As an extra service to the society we have decided that if a girl-child is born under this scheme, she will be given a scholarship to take care of her educational needs. We have also decided to extend the facility to one month after delivery.



## Atmanirbhar - Women Self Help Group



We have taken the initiative to help financially unstable women, where they reside as slum dwellers, to become independent by imparting various skills such as stitching, embroidery, and tailoring. These skills will enable them to earn a livelihood, gain financial independence, and improve their quality of life. Through this initiative, our aim is not only to empower women but to also create a positive impact on their families and communities. By offering training, support, and access to resources, Naya Sawera help them build a better future for themselves.



Through this AatmaNirbhar Women Self Help Group, we are currently working on stitching projects and provide a platform to the ladies to help them exhibit cloth bags at nominal rates. We have helped more than 22 families from poor financial backgrounds so far to become self sufficient.





## नया सवेरा ने महिलाओं के आर्थिक सशक्तिकरण हेतु स्वयं सहायता समूह का किया गठन

जयपुर। नया सवेरा पिछले 10 वर्षों से महिलाओं के स्वास्थ्य, शिक्षा, अधिकार और सशक्तिकरण के लिए कार्य करता आ रहा है, जिसमें की निशुल्क सेनेटरी पैड्स का वितरण, गर्भवती महिलाओं की सहायता, बालिकाओं की शिक्षा, महिला अधिकारों के बारे में जागरूकता और स्वयं के व्यवसाय के लिए आर्थिक सहायता आदि हैं। संस्था महिलाओं के सुदृढ़ आर्थिक सशक्तिकरण के लिए कदम बढ़ाते हुए स्वयं सहायता समूहों का गठन करने जा रही है जिनके जरिये महिलाओं द्वारा विभिन्न प्रकार के उत्पाद बनाये जायेंगे और संस्था द्वारा उनका विपणन किया जायेगा। नया सवेरा के फाउंडर अखिलेश माहेश्वरी ने बताया की आज हमने गिरधारीपूरा बस्ती में पहला बैठक का आयोजन किया। बैठक के जरिये प्रथम समूह का गठन किया गया। इस बैठक में आसी महिलाओं ने अपने-अपने हुनर के बारे में बताया। महिलाएं समूह से जुड़कर अपना-अपना हुनर दुनिया के सामने रखना चाहती हैं। नया सवेरा इसके लिए महिलाओं को मंच उपलब्ध करवाएगा, उनके बनाये उत्पादों की कला-प्रदर्शनियां लगवायेगा और विभिन्न माध्यमों से विपणन करवाएगा। इससे होने वाली आय से महिलाओं में आर्थिक आत्मविश्वास बढ़ेगा और वे अपने बच्चों को अच्छी शिक्षा, परिवार के स्वास्थ्य और पोषण में सहयोग कर पाएगी।



Through Stitching & Tailoring Work, the Self Help Group made for the purpose of Women Empowerment is capable of doing all types of bulk and small scale stitching work. Thus year, they started with Summer Coat, Kurtis, Various Clothes Bags and many more other items.



## Stories of ATMANIRBHAR



### SHANKAR SINGH CHARAN

Shankar Singh, a hardworking auto driver, dedicated his days and nights to provide for his family's basic needs.

Unfortunately, their lives took a tragic turn when Shankar's wife was involved in an accident. The accident not only resulted in the loss of their rented house but also took away their only source of income, the rickshaw, which was stolen.

Witnessing their desperate situation, Naya Sawera stepped forward to lend a helping hand. We offered immediate shelter and food, and also took the responsibility of paying their monthly rent until Shankar and his family could regain their financial stability. It was a gesture filled with compassion and empathy.

Furthermore, through the Atmanirbhar Parivar Yojna, Naya Sawera provided Shankar Singh with a cycle trolley rickshaw, enabling him to have a means of income once again. This act of support and assistance gave Shankar renewed hope and a chance to rebuild his life, ensuring a brighter future for his family.

### SHEETAL DEVI CHOUDHRY

Sheetal Devi, a dedicated and hardworking woman, used to support her family of six by working as domestic help in their neighborhood. However, when the lockdown was imposed, her services were abruptly discontinued. This unfortunate situation meant that she couldn't afford to continue her children's education, causing great distress.

In her time of need, Sheetal reached out to Naya Sawera, seeking assistance. With utmost care and consideration, Naya Sawera stepped in to support her. They covered the costs of setting up a vegetable stall for Sheetal's husband, providing him with an opportunity for employment. This was a crucial lifeline that would enable Sheetal's family to meet their basic needs and expenses.

The compassionate intervention of Naya Sawera brought new hope into Sheetal's life. It not only addressed their immediate financial difficulties but also created a pathway for self-sufficiency. The vegetable stall would become a means for Sheetal's husband to earn a living and support their family.

# Activities



## Fruitmania

As we all enjoy the summer season with cool drinks, seasonal fruits, and the much-loved mangoes and watermelon, we must not forget that there are underprivileged children who don't even have access to a proper meal, let alone seasonal fruits. Our NGO recognizes this issue and aims to provide these children with a day full of fruit-filled enjoyment during our annual fruit festival. We serve unlimited fruits of various delicious kinds, allowing the children to enjoy the taste and health benefits of fruits to their heart's content. Our fruit festival not only provides these children with a fun day but also encourages them to adopt healthy eating habits.

## Walk Against Hunger Food For All

We are running a Community Kitchen where we are serving meal twice a week to 50 Kids who are malnourished and old age people & pregnant women.

We understand the need of regular outings and special activities to stimulate children's creativity while fulfilling their requirement of entertainment. We organize regular visits to the cinema and other places like magic shows.

# Ullaas

Our NGO organizes an annual event for underprivileged kids, aimed at providing them with a day full of joy and excitement. The event features a variety of activities including dance performances, a magic show, puppet show, and even a tattoo artist. We also organize games, music, and provide a breakfast and lunch, along with ice cream, toffees, and gifts to make the children feel special. The aim of the event is to give the kids a chance to experience something they may not have had the opportunity to do before, creating a lasting memory that they can cherish for years to come. We believe that every child deserves a day to feel special and loved, and we strive to make that a reality through this annual event.

Donors got to meet the children whose education they finance under 'Each One Educate One' scheme. They danced, singed and played together. It was a one-on-one interaction. An emotional connection could be seen in this event.

The children who gathered in the event belong to the lowest section of society, some even considered untouchables. These children, who barely manage to survive till youth, feed on one meal a day, are covered with discarded clothes and find happiness in the smallest things. Some of them have suffered psychological traumas and discrimination. Few of them, despite their young age, work at some dhabas or stalls. While other children enjoy chocolates, ice-creams and toys at this age; these children are forced to work for their survival. Giving a day of happiness cannot compensate for the whole year, but it can surely give them a break from backbreaking work and a hope for a better future.

This event belongs to our stakeholders and to our volunteers and interns. A time to share their experiences and joy, while serving the community. This is the youth of Rajasthan coming forward for a noble cause. They are well aware of their responsibility and believe in giving back to the society. A day full of laughter, hopes, smiles and healing.

जयपुर। प्रदेश में बाल श्रम एवं बाल दुर्व्यापार पर प्रभावी रोकथाम के लिए राज्य सरकार द्वारा अग्रिम निर्णय लिए जा रहे हैं। राज्य सरकार को ऐसे मामलों पर गहन अध्ययन कर समाधान देने के लिए एक उच्चाधिकार प्राप्त समिति के गठन और संरचना के प्रस्ताव को मंजूरी प्रदान की है। जिसमें समाजसेवी एवं बाल अधिकार कार्यकर्ता अखिलेश माहेश्वरी को मुख्यमंत्री राजस्थान सरकार द्वारा सदस्य बनाया गया।

अखिलेश माहेश्वरी द्वारा समाज सेवा के क्षेत्र में वर्ष 2009 में नया संस्था संस्था की स्थापना की। संस्था द्वारा बच्चों, महिलाओं, बुजुर्गों और असाक्षरों के लिए कई परियोजनाओं



का संचालन किया जा रहा है। इन्होंने राजस्थान सरकार के सामाजिक न्याय एवं अधिकारिता विभाग, बाल अधिकारिता विभाग, श्रम विभाग राजस्थान बाल संरक्षण आयोग, बाल कल्याण समिति और बाल मुक्ता इकाई जयपुर के साथ मिलकर विविध बालश्रम, बाल तस्करी और बाल शोषण के विरुद्ध अभियानों का नेतृत्व किया है और जनजागरूकता अभियान चलाए हैं।

अखिलेश माहेश्वरी के नेतृत्व में नया संस्था संस्थापक द्वारा ओपन सेंटर होम का संरचना किया जा रहा है। जिसमें अधिकांश और गरीबी से कारण बालश्रम के दलदल में धकेले गए, काम डू में जीने के लिए अटोकाए करती बालश्रमिक चण्डल ट्रेफिकिंग, घर से भागे हुए, छोड़े हुए शिशुवृत्ति करने वाले बालकों बालकों को रख जाता है। संस्था द्वारा अभी तक 400 से अधिक बच्चों को सुरक्षित पुनर्वासित किया गया है।
